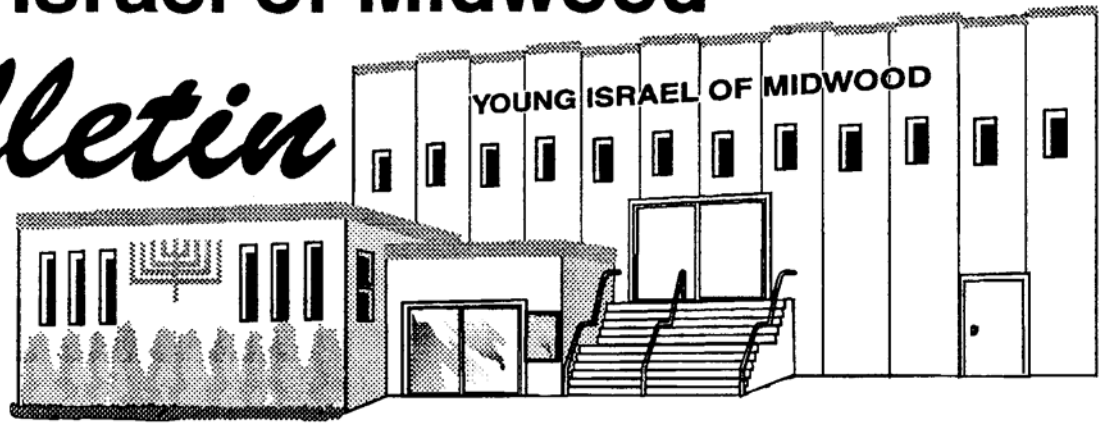

### FROM THE RABBI'S DESK

Dear fellow *mispallel*,

Every day during the month of Elul after *shaharis* we blow the *shofar*. We all recognize it as a call to *teshuva*. But in our tradition other reasons are also given. One is *learbev es hasatan*, to confuse and confound the accuser. For when he hears the sound of the *shofar* blowing, he thinks it is the *shofar* of *mashiach*, which would sound his death knell.

This explanation appears far-fetched. After all, the *satan*, after so many years, should realize that we blow *shofar* every Elul and still *mashiach* hasn't come.


I would like to suggest the following explanation.

The *shofar* of *mashiach* will herald the final triumph over evil. But our individual and communal *teshuva* each year is itself a victory in the ongoing human struggle with the forces of *chet*. The final victory, which the *shofar* of *mashiach* will announce, will be made up of the many small victories symbolized by the *shofar* of Elul and Rosh Hashanah. Each Elul brings us closed to this goal. And each year when we blow the *shofar* we hope that this time the sound that we blow will become the *shofar shel mashiach*. It is that possibility which dismays the accuser.

May all our enemies likewise be dismayed, and may we soon hear sounded the *shofar gadol leherusenu*, the "great *shofar* of our deliverance".
